1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 1:04 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

3. ACTION CALENDAR

A. CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALLEJO RATIFYING A PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY BY THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND RATIFYING AN ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF VALLEJO IMPOSING AN 8 P.M. CURFEW IN THE CITY OF VALLEJO UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

Interim City Attorney Risner reviewed the staff report and outlined the recommendation.

Staff responded to questions from Councilmembers. Councilmembers provided comment.

Action: Moved by Vice Mayor Sunga and carried unanimously to adopt Resolution No. 20-061 N.C. as revised granting the Director of Emergency Services the authority to rescind the curfew.

Following the announcement of the closed session item, the City Council convened into a separate teleconference Closed Session at 1:30 p.m. Staff members present were City Manager Nyhoff, Interim City Attorney Risner, Assistant City Manager Cardwell, Deputy City Attorney Knight, and Police Chief Williams.
