

RESOLUTION NO. 25-063 N.C.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VALLEJO
APPOINTING THREE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO THE STANDING
PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2011 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 11-173 N.C. establishing a City Council Public Safety Committee consisting of 2 members; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2012 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-023 N.C. which in part increased the size of the Committee to 3 members and defined the specific objectives of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-037 N.C. which in part specifically reduced the membership of the Committee from 3 to 2 councilmembers and defined the specific objectives of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-050 N.C. which in part reaffirmed the membership of the Committee at 2 councilmembers and the specific objectives of the Committee; and

WHEREAS, as reaffirmed in Resolution No. 12-050 N.C., the committee shall consist of 2 members and the purpose and responsibilities of the City Council standing Public Safety Committee are as follows:

1. Receive referrals and make recommendations to the City Council regarding public safety issues within the City Council's discretion.
2. Review opportunities for public safety cost savings, revenue opportunities and enhanced technology to create a safer community.
3. Review ongoing enhancements of public safety underway in the police and fire departments (e.g. Implementation of Assessment Report items).

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase the membership of the Committee from 2 to 3 councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, California state law allows for the creation of City Council standing committees which are subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Vallejo resolves as follows:

1. The purpose and responsibilities of the City Council standing Public Safety Committee are as outlined above.

2. The membership of the Committee shall consist of three members of the City Council appointed by a majority of the City Council.
3. The standing Public Safety Committee is subject to the Ralph M. Brown Act and must comply with the Act.
4. Councilmembers Lediju, Matias and Palmares are hereby appointed to such committee.
