VI. PRESENTATIONS AND COMMENDATIONS

A. Proclamation Recognizing September 2025 as Public Schools Month

Mayor Andrea Sorce read and presented a proclamation for Public Schools Month to Gerald Bettman, representative of Naval Lodge No. 87, who has continuously made donations and other contributions to the Vallejo City Unified School District. Mr. Bettman spoke about the goals of the lodge and its purpose for supporting Public Schools Month.

VII. INTER-AGENCY UPDATES

Police Chief Jason Ta, spoke about the monthly check-in meetings and relationship with Superintendent Rubén Aurelio and some of the changes that will be occurring with the addition of a contract agreement for support from the Solano County Sheriff's Department. Chief Ta reported the department will be increasing traffic enforcement in the city, whether it be warnings, and/or citations. Sergeant Rashaad Hollis reported information about the National Night Out. Antony Ryans, representative of GVRD, reported information on upcoming events in October and November. Mr. Ryans reported GVRD received a \$7.2 million grant to improve the Franklin Recreation Facility fields and provide other resources for programs.

VIII. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Mare Island Bridge Construction

Sam Kumar, representative of Vallejo Public Works, reported that the traffic direction will be changed for Mare Island traffic to exit off of the Island on the east side of Highway 37 and incoming traffic onto the island will be from the west entrance. This change will come into effect in early October and will continue until 2027. NOte dates October 22 and 23rd.

B. School Closure Update

Superintendent Rubén Aurelio reported updates regarding the District's current school closure and consolidation information and the direction of the processes to complete before the final decisions are made.

IX. YOUTH COORDINATOR UPDATES

A. Prop 64 Update

Victoria Grace-Barksdale, Vallejo Youth Coordinator, introduced Apostle Anthony Summers, who will be working with the city through Healthy Vallejo to promote projects for Vallejo youth while helping to revitalize and clean up the city. Vallejo received a \$2.4 million grant to help fund various programs to employ and train Vallejo young people for the workforce.
