I. CALL TO ORDER

President Fox called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Mayor Andrea Sorce, City of Vallejo is absent.

Delores Johnson, Tausha Johnson, Ernani Santos, Jasmine Taylor, Vanessa Oden, and Ramona Bishop, spoke in person and Jeremy Geronimo spoke on Zoom on behalf of Elite Charter School about a resolution to improve the facilities their campus is on. Community members became disruptive at the meeting.

President Fox recessed the meeting at 4:56 p.m.

President Fox reconvened the meeting at 5:15 p.m.

VI. PRESENTATIONS AND COMMENDATIONS

VII. INTER-AGENCY UPDATES

Chief Jason Ta, Vallejo Police Department, introduced Sergeant Rashad Hollis and spoke about the security towers that are installed in various places in the city to deter and help with crime investigations. Two are already utilized and five more are deployed and placed strategically to deal with illegal dumping and sex trafficking. Chief Ta said more Traffic Officers are expected to be added to begin enforcement of traffic safety in the city, along with more participation in Safe Routes to Schools activities with the Team Problem Oriented Policing Team (POP Team). Sergeant Hollis presented information regarding immigration activity regarding I.C.E., public safety and constitutional rights regarding deportation and that the Vallejo Police Department is not involved with the activities of I.C.E.

Vice President Glenn Amboy asked about the VPD scout program they had in the past with VCUSD. Sergeant Hollis said VPD has a similar program called the Explore Program, and they currently have a couple of VCUSD students participating on the weekends earning community hours in learning CPR and participating with other organizations as volunteers. Sergeant Hollis also spoke about the relationship with Cave Language Academy, having an open house for families at the school site. The VPD is also communicating with administrators in the District to incorporate a Public Safety Committee pathway within the schools, including having a program like the Law Academy at Jesse Bethel High School, added to Vallejo High School. Student Trustee Sonia Valdez Jacobo asked if the VPD is planning to have training for Latino students and families on how to respond to immigration officers if they encounter them. Sergeant Hollis said he would bring that question to VCUSD.

VIII. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Mare Island Causeway Bridge Construction

Sam Kumara, Project Planning Engineer, reported that traffic on the Causeway Bridge is now flowing one-way. There will be a two-day closure that will be updated to November 5th and 6th. The project is slated to be completed on January 5, 2027. Superintendent Rubén Aurelio thanked Mr. Kumara and the engineering staff for the change in direction of the bridge that has made a tremendous impact on employees and students arriving to work and school. Councilmember J.R. Matulac applauded Assistant Superintendent Matthew Chamberlain for the communication efforts that alerted VCUSD staff of the bridge updates.

B. Rollingwood Avenue (Subdivision Entitlements)

Kristen Pollit, Planning and Developing Services Director, reported that the Planning Commission originally had a hearing scheduled for October 6, 2025, but needed additional time to work through some of the conditions of approval primarily related to water. Ms. Pollit reported that the commission is close to resolution of those items and the meeting is rescheduled for November 3, 2025.

President Fox said he appreciates the report and whatever that can be done to expedite the process.

C. Nebraska Street Closure

Ms. Pollit reported that they have been able to look at information they've received to be able to figure out the correct path for CEQA compliance to put the project in place. Ms. Pollit said the conclusion is that they are supportive of a CEQA exemption and would file the document needed for exemption. Traffic Engineer, Tony Chu, reported that funding is the current delay, but they have quotes for 40-foot pipe gates that span from east of the Vallejo Plunge (pool) parking lot, so you can route around to make a U-turn on the west and east end. The timeline is during school hours starting at 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The cost of installation is from \$14,000 to \$30,000 per site. Once the contractor and purchase order are in place, the project may take approximately one month. Andrew Murray, City Manager, spoke about the City of Vallejo and VCUSD sharing the cost of the project to assist with the funding solution. President Fox asked if all the numbers and details of the information needed, along with possible grants could be identified. Councilmember Matulac suggested he would look into grant funding that may be available for the project. City Councilmember Helen Cookie Gordon spoke about concerns of students having to walk to school and parents needing to get to the sites, and she's happy to hear that this conversation is happening for the safety of the students.

A. Vallejo Youth Delegation

Victoria Grace-Barksdale, Youth Coordinator, City of Vallejo, reported there are 23 applicants for the next Youth Delegation trip to Salt Lake City, Utah. Ms. Barksdale asked the applicants to turn in their forms as soon as possible for the committee to review and make selections of attendees. G.V.R.D. has opened up grant funds access for youth sports teams and recreation groups to receive funds for activities.

Public Comment: A community member spoke about funding for Elite Public Schools and how disappointed he was that the district didn't approve the application process. The community

member asked the VCUSD Board to reconsider their position on the matter.
