**VII. VALLEJO POLICE DEPARTMENT UPDATES**

Sergeant Rashad Hollis, Vallejo Police Department Public Information Officer, reported that the Vallejo Police Department has updated its process on handling domestic violence restraining order calls and human trafficking and collaboration with local organizations for resources and support for victims and families involved in these situations in Vallejo. The VPD also approved a new mascot (pet dog) to help improve community engagement. The VPD is continuing its Community Watch meetings tonight at the Florence Douglas Center where the community can speak, ask questions and engage with VPD and city staff. Sergeant Hollis encourages neighborhoods, business owners and community members to work together to promote safety and security in the city.

**VIII. INTER-AGENCY UPDATES**

Antony Ryans, G.V.R.D. Migration Services Director, reported information about the Community Updates meeting that was recently held regarding Prop. 68 funds that were received from the state, updates regarding the Franklin Sports Complex and available parking at the site. Renovations of the fields (soccer, football, softball) are expected to be completed in 2027, to help mitigate the inconsistencies and challenges for access to the fields. Mr. Ryans reported the renovations included basketball and pickleball courts. G.V.R.D. holiday activities started with a tree lighting ceremony last week and a toy giveaway and Festival of lights coming up on December 19-22, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., that is free for families to enjoy.

**IX. DISCUSSION ITEMS**

**A. Nebraska Street Closure**

A representative of the City of Vallejo reported that there are two quotes for fenced gates to support the closure of Nebraska Street during school hours. The lowest quote is \$12,000 for two gates and the city could get them installed within three weeks once the funding is in place. The city would depend on VCUSD staff to open and close the gates. President Fox is hoping the installation can happen for the 2026 school year.

**X. YOUTH COORDINATOR UPDATES**

Victoria Grace-Barksdale, City Youth Coordinator, reported information about the Youth Delegates from Vallejo taking a trip to Utah to attend a conference for students. Ms. Barksdale reported that the Vallejo students were exceptional when they spoke and collaborated with other youth delegates. The youth delegates learned a lot and were able to network with other delegates from around the state.
