- Setting forth two members of the POAC as appointed to the IPA Ad Hoc Subcommittee.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Police Oversight and Accountability Ordinance, Section 18.04.010 of the Vallejo Municipal Code ordinance requires that the City Manager select an Independent Police Auditor after receiving advice and input from the POAC. In order to effectively provide advice and input to the City Manager, the POAC has the power to create an ad hoc subcommittee for the express purpose of reviewing the proposals in response to the RFP for the Independent Police Auditor (IPA). The Ad-Hoc Subcommittee would review the proposals and provide advice and input to the full Commission. The full Commission, in turn, would provide its advice and input to the City Manager, who would ultimately make a final determination in accordance with section 18.04.010.

FISCAL IMPACT

The appointment of the subcommittee itself has no direct financial impact to the City. Financial impact will be determined based upon the ultimate selection by the City Manager.

A RESOLUTION OF THE POLICE OVERSIGHT AND ACCOUNTABILITY COMMISSION (POAC) OF THE CITY OF VALLEJO ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC SUBCOMMITTEE FOR REVIEW OF PROPOSALS FOR INDEPENDENT POLICE AUDITOR (IPA PROPOSALS)

3. That the duties of the Subcommittee shall be reviewing proposals sent to the City in response to an RFP for IPA services and provide advice and input to the POAC which in turn can use the provided information to provide advice and input to the City Manager concerning the IPA.
4. That the following two members of the POAC are hereby appointed to the IPA Ad Hoc Subcommittee.
