### **A. Vallejo Youth Delegation**

Students who attended the Vallejo Youth Delegation trip will be presenting at the May 12, 2026, City Council meeting and at the May 13, 2026, VCUSD Board Meeting. Six students attended the trip. Mrs. Grace-Barksdale's highlight was seeing the students grow. The students were able to visit Congressman Garamendi's office, who was holding a committee meeting about the coast guard regarding ship building. Vallejo and Mare Island were mentioned. It was a great opportunity for the students to experience their city being talked about directly in a congressional hearing.

### **B. Prop. 64 Grant**

The Prop 64 Grant goes through 2028. Substance abuse workshops are still being held on Vallejo High School's campus and a MOU renewal with Club Stride is in the process with hopes to expand to Jesse Bethel High School in the future.

Due to a technical memo from a resident living in the Vallejo High School area, another traffic impact analysis and report has been initiated and is in progress for four additional intersections and roughly ten roadway segments on the east and west sides of Vallejo High School. Trustee Fox asked for the timeline on this report. Tony Chu, Transportation Superintendent, City of Vallejo, anticipates that the report should be ready by May. Trustee Young asked for clarification regarding the concerns addressed in the letter and asked if the city communicated with the community for their input. Robert Briseño, Communications and Public Information Officer, City of Vallejo, stated he was in charge of the outreach for the project. Because of the outreach that was being conducted by the city, a resident wrote in a letter regarding concerns. The letter prompted the City's Attorney's office to look closer into the project. Because there was a change in law, an additional report was requested to satisfy the California Environmental Quality Act (CQEA) report. The community's response to the outreach was fairly positive, with the biggest concern being students parking outside the gates, in the neighborhood, as opposed to parking near the school site. Trustee Fox emphasized the reason for initiating the project is for student safety and hopes for the project to be completed by summer. Mayor Sorce proposed looking at the process and finding the hole to prevent a similar situation from occurring again. However, in this case, the law changed after the initial report was done, causing the city to have to proceed with an additional report. The street closure will only occur on school days, during school hours. Correct signage will be posted in the surrounding areas as well as on the gates.
