The PBSC will discuss the Get Out the Vote (GOTV) strategy for the Cycle 7 vote, including GOTV outreach assignments, and expos.

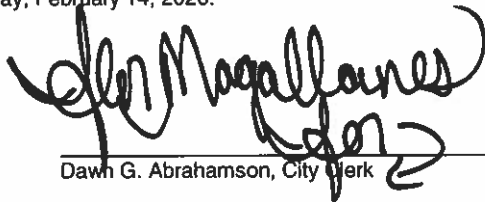
