CITY OF VALLEJO ADOPT-A-STREET/BLOCK PROGRAM SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Acceptance of, and adherence to, these safety conditions are requirements of participation in the City of Vallejo's Adopt-a-Street/Block Program.

While cleaning your adopted area, remember: **SAFETY FIRST!**

- Stay off the roadway.
- Use caution when crossing the street, roadway, public facility, public parking area, park, public open space, and trail. Use crosswalks and signals where available.
- FACE ONCOMING TRAFFIC AS YOU WORK AND KEEP AN EYE ON TRAFFIC. Be prepared to move quickly if necessary.
- Discontinue work before dusk.
- Do not attempt to work when fog or other conditions reduce visibility for drivers.
- Do not attempt to work when the road is icy or wet.
- Do not touch or attempt to remove materials that you suspect may be toxic or hazardous. Items to avoid include powders, chemicals, smelly substances, suspicious packages, chemical drums or containers, weapons, syringes or hypodermic needles, dead or wounded animals, and broken glass. Immediately notify the City of Vallejo, Public Works Department, or the Vallejo Police Department of the location of weapons or suspected toxic substances.
- Do not try to compact trash bags. Injuries from broken or jagged objects may occur.
- Wear the supplied safety vests whenever you are working in your adopted area.
- Gloves are recommended.
- Wear long pants and substantial, leather shoes or boots with ankle support. Watch your footing and stay off steep slopes, drainage facilities or places from which you might fall. Light-colored clothing, long sleeved shirts and sun screen lotion are recommended.
- Avoid overexertion. Drink plenty of water, especially on warm, humid days. Do not consume alcoholic beverages before or during your cleanup event.
- Be alert for places where snakes may be located. Also, be alert for stinging insects and poisonous plants; i.e., Poison Oak.
- Participants' vehicles shall be legally located off the traveled way so as not to interfere with the free flow of traffic.



CITY OF VALLEJO ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Acceptance of and adherence to these conditions are requirements of participation in the City of Vallejo's Adopt-a-Street program:

- Streets, roadways, public facilities, public parking areas, parks, public open spaces, and trails may be adopted for cleanup. If one or more streets are adopted, the entire street(s) (both sides) must be cleaned. If the street is more than one mile long, the minimum area to be adopted is one mile (both sides of the street).
- Areas adopted for cleanup must be cleaned a minimum of four times per year. A City representative will periodically inspect adopted areas. Areas not being cleaned according to the guidelines of the Adopt-a-Street Program will be put up for adoption to other interested parties.
- Participation by an individual or group may be canceled by the City for non conformance with Program provisions, failure to keep the adopted area in reasonably clean condition or failure to adhere to directions given by the City's representative.
- Each Participant shall attend a safety orientation conducted by the Adopt-a-Street Captain prior to participating in the Adopt-a-Street Program. The orientation shall include a discussion and explanation of the Safety Requirements. The City's representative may exclude any person from the work area upon a determination that the person has failed to adhere to the safety requirements of this Program.
- The Adopt-a-Street Captain shall keep the approved Adopt-a-Street Program Application and the Waiver of Liability or copies thereof at the site of the work and must show it to any City representative or any law enforcement officer on demand. **WORK SHALL BE SUSPENDED IF THE APPROVED ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM APPLICATION AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY ARE NOT AT THE JOB SITE AS PROVIDED.**
- Participants understand and agree that doing any work under this Program shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions of this Program.
- Participants' work shall be subordinate to operations that the City may conduct and shall not interfere with City work crews or City contractors.
- Participants performing work under this Program shall wear safety vests while collecting litter.
- Participants' work shall be conducted during daylight hours.
- If weather or other adverse circumstances cause a public hazard, Participants' work shall be immediately discontinued.

1. Contact the Adopt-A-Street/Block Captain when your application has been approved.
2. Provide Community Clean Up Tool Trailer stocked with safety vests, bags, litter grabbers, and safety signs if needed.

Before your cleanup event:

1. Call the City representative who approved your application at least one day before your cleanup event.
2. Provide a safety orientation and provide safety equipment to all group members before working, as outlined in the Conditions of Participation and Safety Requirements, contained in this packet.
3. Be sure that all workers in your group have signed the Waiver of Liability (**Remember, all participants must sign the Waiver of Liability prior to participation**).

Have fun, be safe, and thank you for participating in the Adopt-A-Street/Block Program.
