MAGAZINE STREET OVERCROSSING TO CLOSE AS INTERSTATE 80 SIX BRIDGES PROJECT CONTINUES

Public Informational Meeting Starts at 4:30 PM on Thursday, April 1, 2021

Caltrans Bay Area is continuing its work on increasing the vertical clearance on six bridges that cross over Interstate 80 (I-80) in the City of Vallejo just north of the Carquinez Bridge.

Caltrans is in the final stages of raising Springs Road Overcrossing and will be re-opening to the traveling public by mid-April 2021.

Once Springs Road is back open, Caltrans will shift its work towards Magazine Street Overcrossing, which will be the next bridge to be raised to meet the current vertical clearance design standard of 16 feet 6 inches.

Caltrans plans to close Magazine Street in May 2021, a complete four-month closure of Magazine Street at I-80 is anticipated to start sometime in Spring 2021.

The six bridges are on I-80 just east of the Carquinez Bridge and will be worked on in this order: Springs Road, Magazine Street, Benicia Road, Georgia Street, Tennessee Street and Redwood Street.

The six bridges do not meet the current vertical clearance design standard of 16 feet 6 inches.

To ensure worker and public safety, westbound and eastbound Magazine Street will be closed to the traveling public for 4 months in the beginning of May 2021 until September 2021.

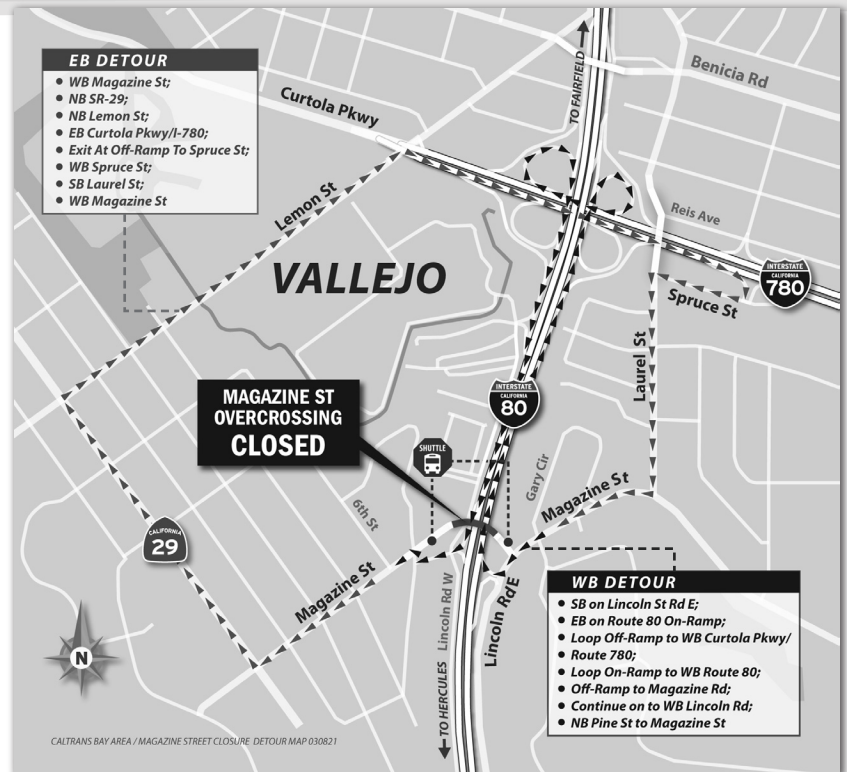

PROJECT LOCATION



PURPOSE & NEED

PURPOSE

To **increase the vertical clearance** to the current standard height of **16 feet 6 inches**.

NEED

Existing minimum vertical clearance ranges between 14.9 feet to 15.3 feet. This needs to be increased to the current standard height **to avoid the bridges from being hit by high load trucks** travelling through the I-80 freight corridor.

THE SIX BRIDGES

The following six bridges crossing over I-80 will be raised to the standard vertical clearance height of 16 feet 6 inches:

- Magazine Street Overcrossing
- Benicia Road Overcrossing
- Georgia Street Overcrossing
- Springs Road Overcrossing (Completed 04/2021)
- Tennessee Street Overcrossing
- Redwood Street Overcrossing



TENTATIVE PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Begin Construction 8/31/20
- End Construction Fall 2022 (2 seasons)

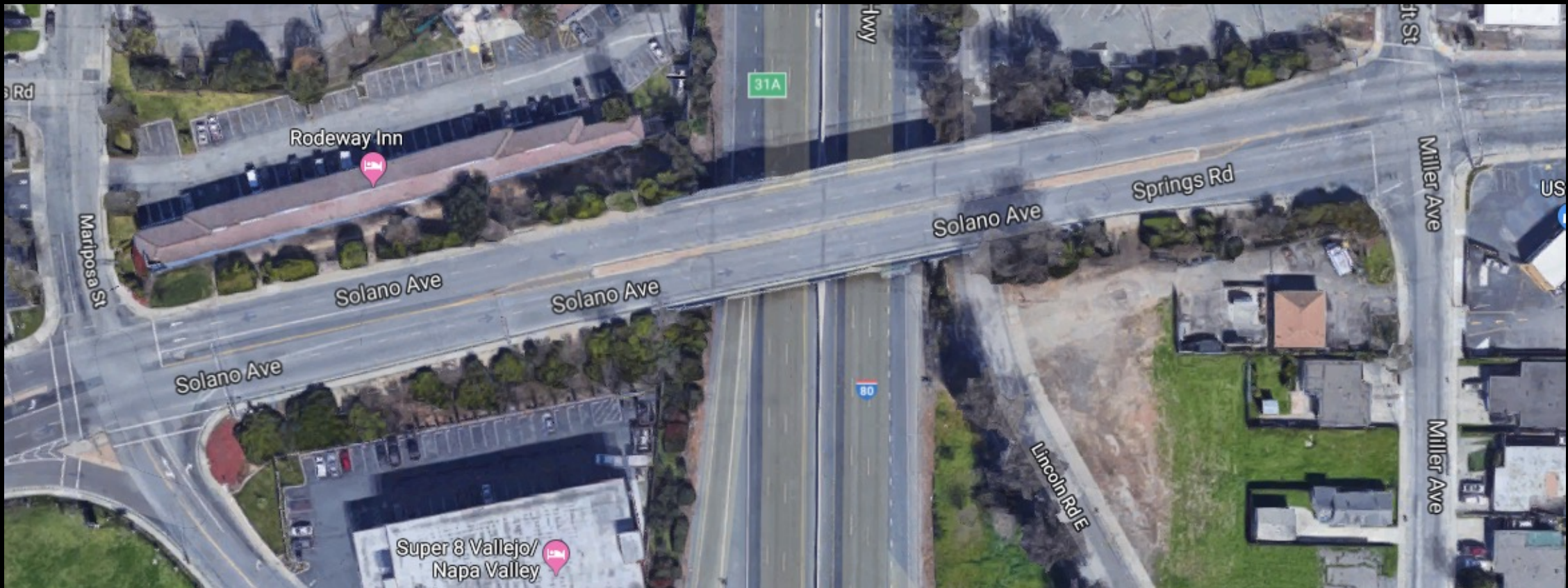
CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE

2. Magazine Street Overcrossing (Starts May 2021)
3. Benicia Road Overcrossing
4. Georgia Street Overcrossing
5. Tennessee Street Overcrossing
6. Redwood Street Overcrossing

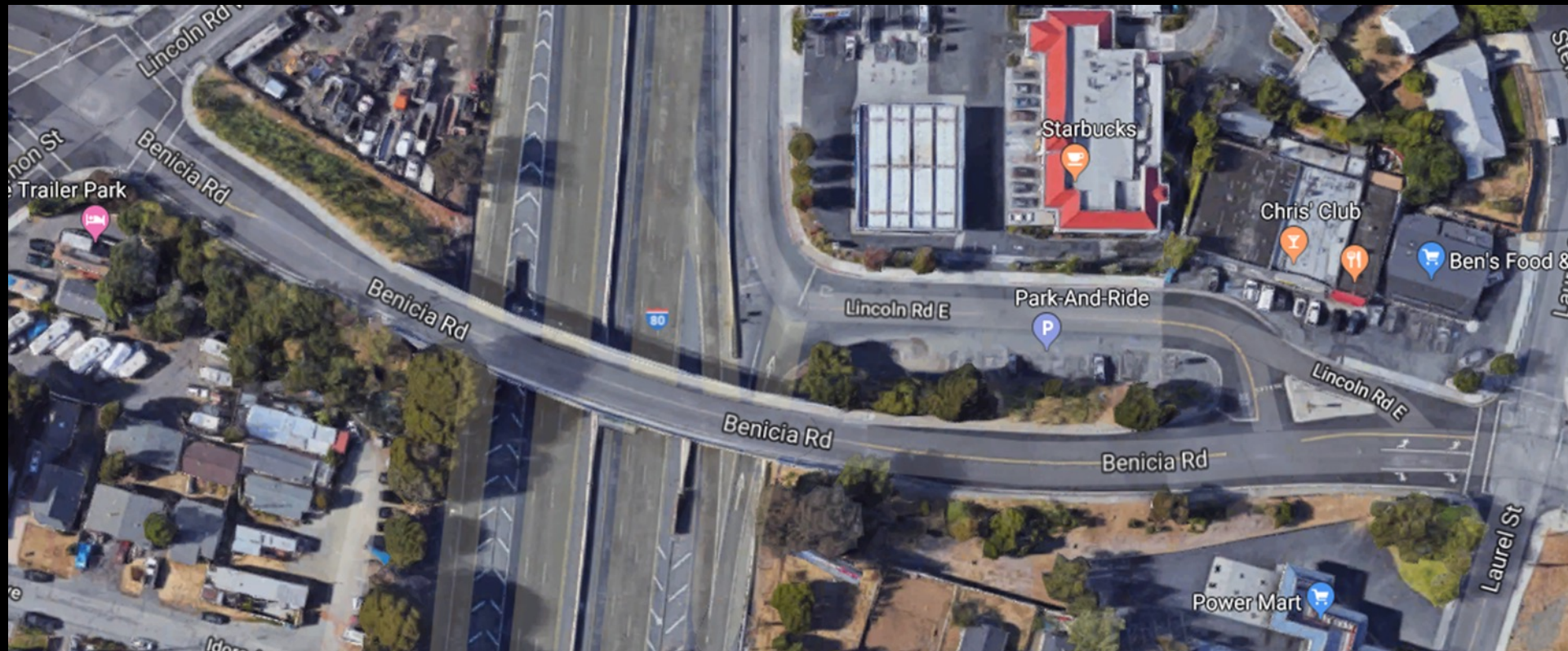

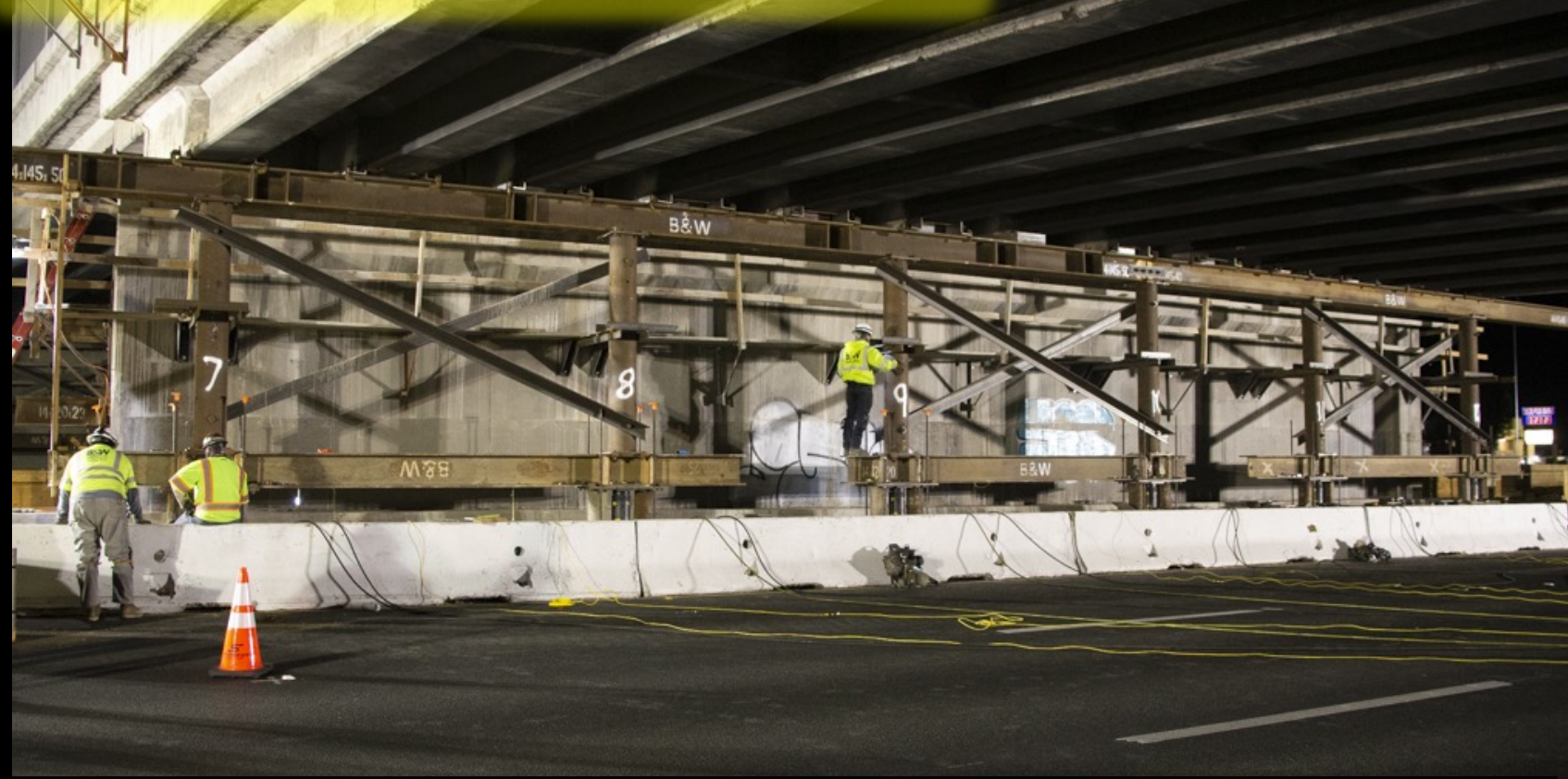


WORK DESCRIPTION

The steps in elevating the bridges include the following:

- Install temporary supports
- Jack up the superstructure
- Set it to its new permanent supports
- Modify the abutments/bridge approaches to conform to the new height

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Lane Reductions on I-80

One to two lanes of I-80 will be closed in each direction for construction at night as needed to prepare for the elevation of each bridge.

Full Closure (one direction only) on I-80

- I-80 will be completely closed in one direction at a time on consecutive nights to elevate the bridge and then repeated to set the bridge down on the new extended supports.
- Each night's complete closure will be limited to a 5-hour window between 11 PM to 4 AM.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Closure of bridge to local traffic

- No more than one bridge will be **completely closed** at any given time, day and night, during the anticipated **four-month duration** of its construction.
- **Detours** will be provided, and extensive public outreach will take place in order to advise the public about the project, the schedule, and the detours.
- **Shuttle service on a 24/7 basis** will also be provided for both pedestrians and bicyclists to navigate the closure of each bridge.

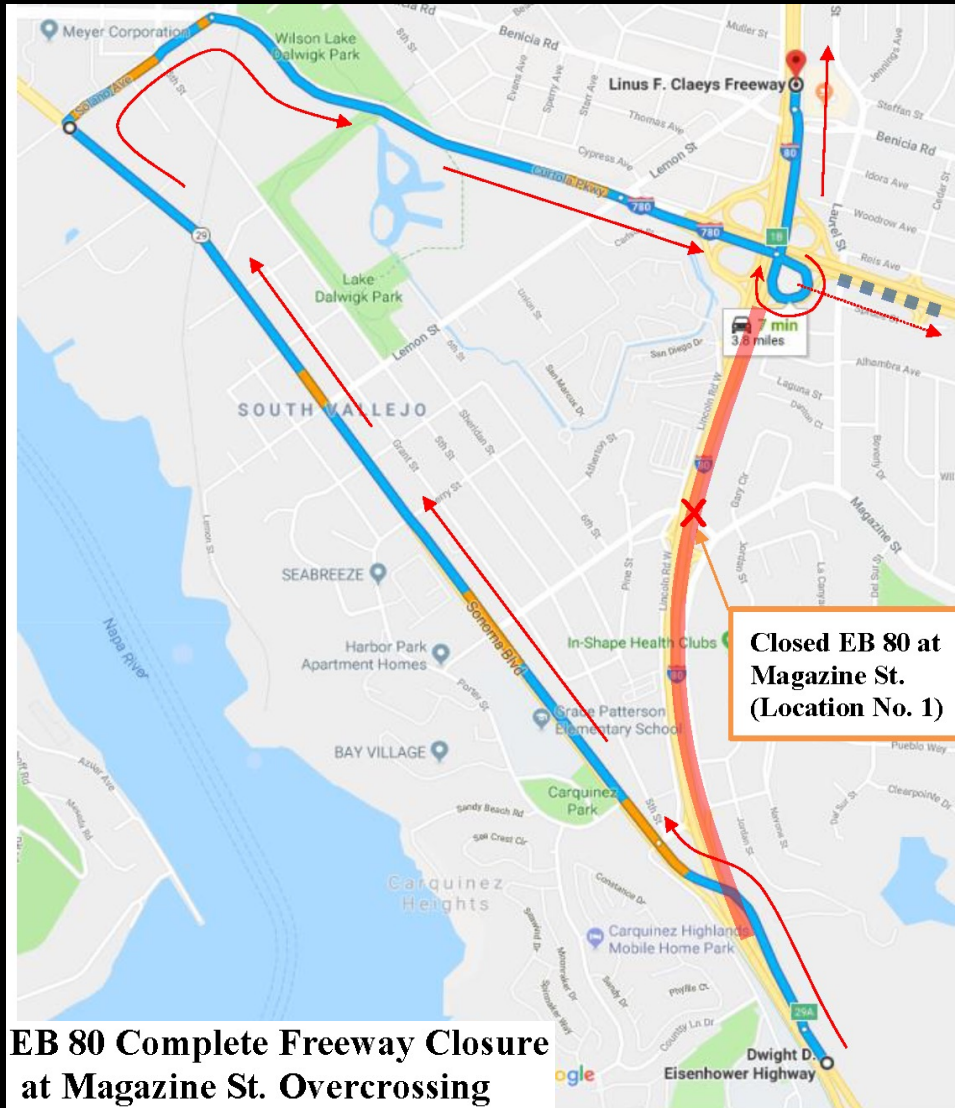

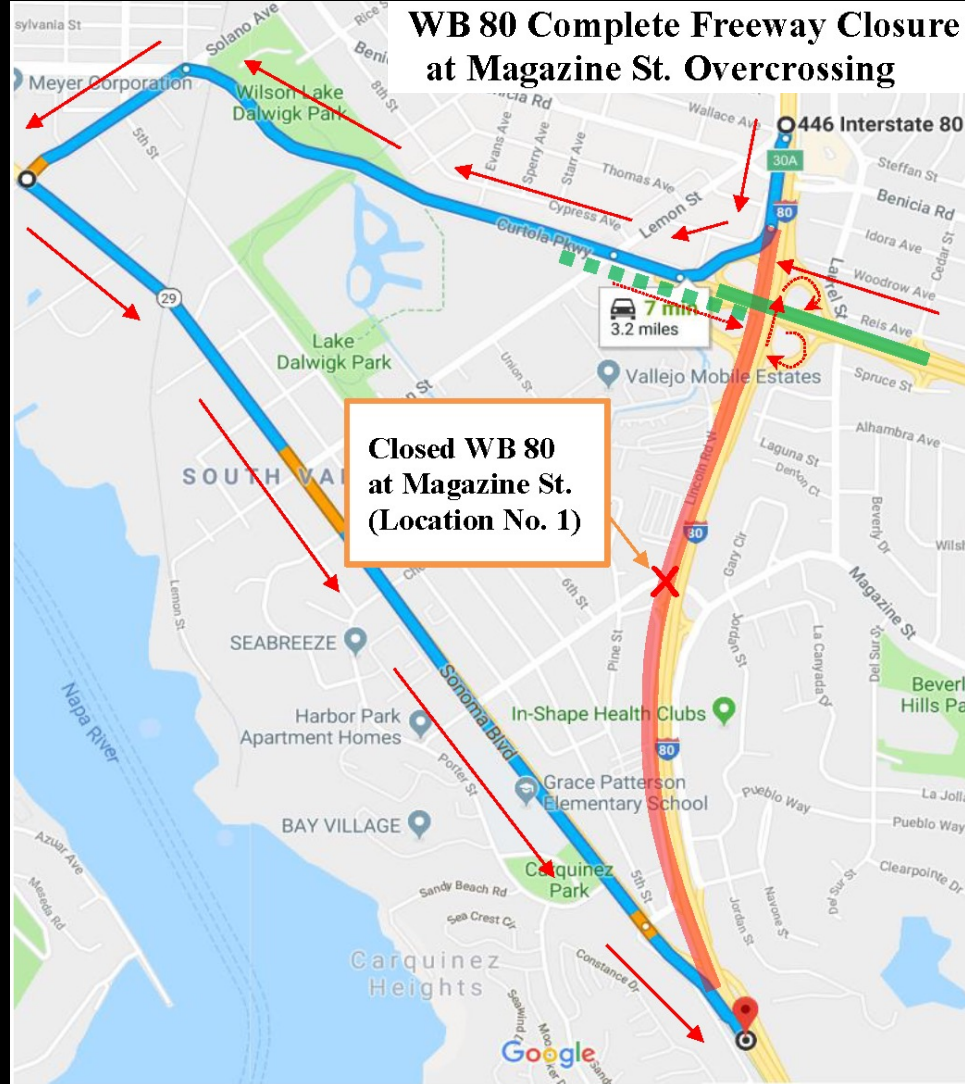
DETOUR PLAN I-80 EB CLOSURE

Magazine Street at I-80 Closed In Spring 2021

Caltrans Bay Area is continuing its work on increasing the vertical clearance on six bridges that cross over Interstate 80 (I-80) in the City of Vallejo just north of the Carquinez Bridge.

The six bridges along I-80 will be worked on in this order: **Springs Road (Completed Spring 2021)**, Magazine Street, Benicia Road, Georgia Street, Tennessee Street and Redwood Street.

The six bridges do not meet the current vertical clearance design standard of 16 feet 6 inches. Caltrans plans to close Magazine Street in May 2021, a complete four-month closure of Magazine Street at I-80 is anticipated to start sometime in May 2021.

Magazine Street Bridge Detour Route

Westbound Detour:
Motorists traveling westbound on Magazine Street will need to head southbound on E. Lincoln Road, then enter onto the EB I-80 On-Ramp toward the I-780 (Curtola Parkway).

Motorists will need to loop on I-780 back onto WB I-80, exiting the Magazine Off-Ramp towards Lincoln Road.

Eastbound Detour:
Motorists traveling eastbound on Magazine Street will need to head north onto State Route 29 (Sonoma Blvd.), taking a right turn on Lemon Street, towards I-780 (Curtola Parkway) traveling eastbound. Motorists will need take the Spruce Avenue Off-Ramp, taking a left turn onto Laurel Avenue to WB Magazine Street.
