Our Mission: To instill community pride by facilitating partnerships with the local businesses and residents of the City of Vallejo towards the Beautification of the City.

Purpose: To recognize Businesses and Homeowners in our Community who have either made or continue to maintain properties either owned or rented in an aesthetically pleasing condition which serves to beautify the neighborhoods of Vallejo.

Summary: Bi-Annually the Commission will open up nominations for Business and Residential Beautification Awards.

Businesses Nominations will open the first week of June with Winners being announced the first Monday in July (unless it falls on a Holiday in which awards will be announced the following day). We can present the physical awards to the winners on July _____, in the City Hall Parking lot (just a suggestion).

Nominations for Residents will be selected by the Beautification Commission. Each Commission Member will be assigned a District to select 3 houses. Commission Member must take an electronic photo and share it with the other Commission Members for voting. Commissioners may not vote on the three that they have selected. Residential voting and winner announcement will take place the October Beautification Commission Meeting. Physical Awards can be presented to the winners on October _____, in the City Hall Parking lot (just a suggestions).

Beautification Commission Members and their immediate families cannot participate in either of the programs and will be immediately eliminated if by chance they are selected while serving on this Board.

Business Award Categories:

- Small Business Beautification
- Maintenance of Existing Facility and Landscaping
- Exterior Reconstruction with Landscaping
- Sustainable Design and Innovation
- Historic and Cultural Preservation
- Cleanest Parking Lot

Residential Award Categories:

- Property enhances the image of the City of Vallejo.
- Property owner/resident made considerable visible improvements to the home/property and yard within the past year.
- Beautification efforts have inspired neighbors to improve their property.
- Best Overall Residential Block in District (all houses to receive a certificate).
