



NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY STATEMENT

The California Department of Transportation, under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, ensures *“No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.”*

DECLARACIÓN DE POLÍTICA DE NO DISCRIMINACIÓN

El Departamento de Transporte de California, bajo el Título VI de la Ley de Derechos Civiles de 1964, asegura que *“Ninguna persona en los Estados Unidos, debido a su raza, color u origen nacional, será excluida de participar, ni se le negarán los beneficios, o será objeto de discriminación, en ningún programa o actividad que reciba ayuda financiera federal.”*

PURPOSE & NEED

PURPOSE

To **increase the vertical clearance** to the current standard height of **16.5 feet**.

NEED

Existing minimum vertical clearance ranges between 14.9 feet to 15.3 feet. This needs to be increased to the current standard height **to avoid the bridges from being hit by high load trucks** travelling through the I-80 freight corridor.

TENTATIVE PROJECT SCHEDULE

Begin Construction

May 16, 2022

End Construction

October 16, 2022



WORK DESCRIPTION

The steps in elevating the bridges include the following:

- Install temporary supports
- Jack up the superstructure
- Set it to its new permanent supports
- Modify the abutments/bridge approaches to conform to the new height

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Lane Reductions on I-80

One to two lanes of I-80 will be closed in each direction for construction at night as needed to prepare for the elevation of each bridge.

Full Closure (one direction only) on I-80

- I-80 will be completely closed in one direction at a time on consecutive nights to elevate the bridge and then repeated to set the bridge down on the new extended supports.
- Each night's complete closure will be limited to a 5-hour window between 11 PM to 4 AM.



TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Closure of bridge to local traffic

- Redwood Street will be closed on May 16, 2022.
- **Detours** will be provided, and extensive public outreach will take place in order to advise the public about the project, the schedule, and the detours.
- **Shuttle service on a 24/7 basis** will also be provided for both pedestrians and bicyclists to navigate the bridge closure.

DETOUR PLAN EB REDWOOD ST.

- EB Redwood St. shuttle stop located across from the Shell Gas Station on Admiral Callahan Lane near the intersection of Admiral Callahan Lane and Redwood Parkway.
- 24-hr shuttle service will be available for pedestrians and bicyclists.

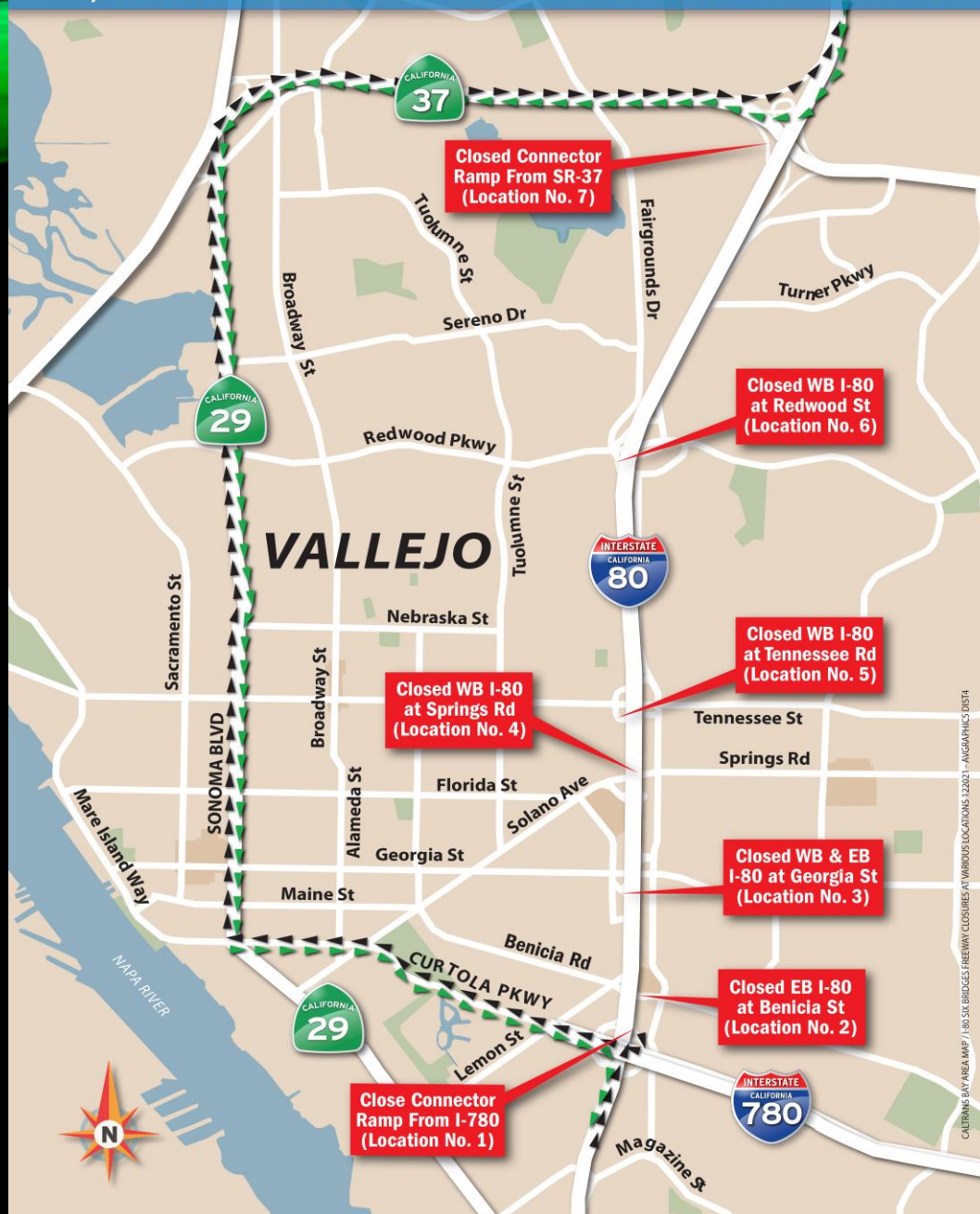

REDWOOD STREET OVERCROSSING CLOSURE

Redwood Street Overcrossing to Close as Interstate 80 Six Bridges Project Continues
Public Informational Meeting Starts at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, May 4, 2022

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Caltrans is continuing its work on increasing the vertical clearance on six bridges which cross over Interstate-80 (I-80) in the City of Vallejo just northeast of the Carquinez Bridge.

SCOPE OF WORK:

Currently, Caltrans is in the final stages of raising the Georgia Street and Tennessee Street overcrossings which were both temporarily closed to traffic in January 2022 and are now tentatively scheduled to reopen to the traveling public by May 2022.

Once the Georgia and Tennessee Street overcrossings are back open, Caltrans will shift its work towards the Redwood Street overcrossing, which will be the final of the I-80 Six Bridges in Vallejo scheduled to be raised to meet the current vertical clearance design standard of 16 feet 6 inches.

REDWOOD STREET OVERCROSSING CLOSED AT I-80 BEGINNING MONDAY, MAY 16, 2022

To ensure worker and public safety, the Redwood Street overcrossing at I-80 will be CLOSED to ALL TRAFFIC starting May 16, 2022. The closure will remain effect for approximately 5 months. Caltrans will make an additional announcement once a specific reopening date for Redwood Street is determined.

During the long-term closure, the following detours will be in effect;

Westbound Redwood Street-Detour Route;

1. Starting at WB Redwood Parkway at Admiral Callahan Lane, right onto NB Admiral Callahan Lane
2. Left onto WB Columbus Parkway/Auto Mall Parkway
3. Take the onramp to WB I-80
4. Stay in the far-right lane on WB I-80
5. Exit Redwood Street from WB I-80

Eastbound Redwood Street-Detour Route:

1. From eastbound Redwood Street at I-80, enter westbound I-80.
2. Continue on westbound I-80.
3. Exit westbound I-80 at Tennessee St. exit.
4. Continue on exit to loop connector onto eastbound Tennessee St.
5. Right onto southbound Humboldt St.
6. From Humboldt St., enter eastbound I-80.
7. Continue on eastbound I-80.

Exit eastbound I-80 at Redwood Parkway

Detour signs will be posted. All work is weather permitting.

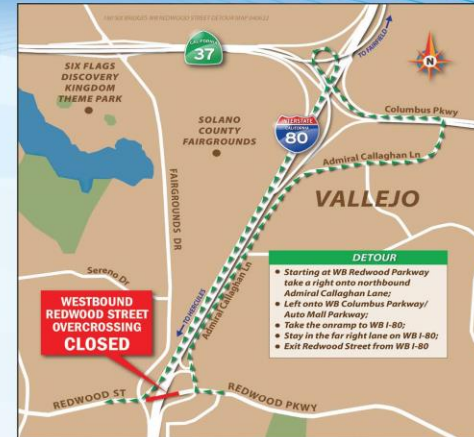
