Chief Assistant City Attorney Risner addressed concerns raised by the speakers.

Councilmembers provided comment and discussion on revisions to the membership of the Police Oversight Board as proposed by Councilmember Brown.

Chief Assistant City Attorney Risner restated the revision as requested by Councilmember Brown.

Councilmembers provided additional comments.

Action: *Moved by Vice Mayor Verder-Aliga and carried to introduce an ordinance to enact Title 18 of the Vallejo Municipal Code to be titled Police Oversight and Accountability and consider adoption at the December 20, 2022 Council meeting as revised at the request of Councilmember Brown to Section 18.030.020-Membership to state the following: the Commission shall consist of 7 members and 2 alternate members appointed by the mayor and City Council. Each Councilmember shall appoint a member who is living within that Councilmember's District. However, if in the opinion of the appointing Councilmember, there are no qualified candidates or in order to fulfill the City's obligation for diversity set forth in Section 18.030.020C, the councilmember may select a candidate outside of their District. It was noted that all appointments will need to be ratified by the full Council (Noes – Arriola).*
