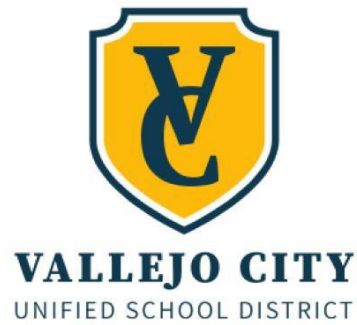

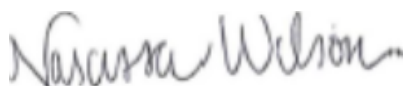

Courtney Davis, a community member, spoke about her organization called Tabby Moms, an organization dedicated to eradicating the barriers to access to mental health. Ms. Davis introduced a grant opportunity and asked the District to take advantage and apply. Councilmember Matulac said he hopes the city and school district can collaborate to take advantage of the grant opportunity that may potentially support the wellness centers on campuses. Councilmember Diaz said she believes this is also something that can be explored for the mobile health units the city is in discussions about.

VI. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Grant Writing Overview

City Grant Writer and Analyst Sydney Wilson introduced the process of identifying specific needs for searching and pursuing grant opportunities for Vallejo. Trustee Fox asked about grants to apply for and get funding for youth activities and sports centers. Councilmember Diaz asked to work with Trustee Fox on drafting a document with their names behind it to push the idea further into fruition by this summer. Mr. Wilson said the city would need assistance from VCUSD to help with the coordination of these grants.

B. Nebraska Street Closure Traffic Study

Mark Helmbrecht, Transportation Manager, and Charmine Solla, Traffic Engineer, reported information on the traffic studies (volume and speed) conducted on and near Nebraska Street. Councilmember Diaz said she proposed the idea and was specifically thinking about school safety related to recent shootings near the campuses. Councilmember Diaz asked if the closure could be a portion of Nebraska near Corbus field and not the entire street. Terry Davis, Assistant City Manager, explained the obstacles of street closures as well as staffing issues related to the reduction of traffic flow. Mr. Davis said there are other alternatives to slowing down traffic on Nebraska Street rather than closing the street entirely.
