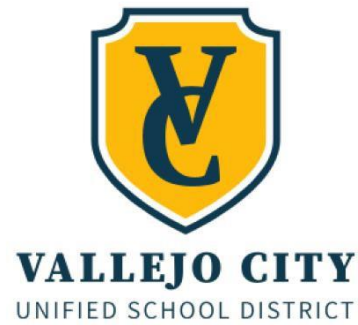

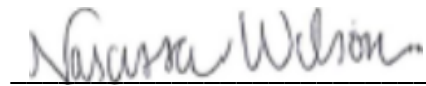

VII. PRESENTATIONS

A. Youth Human Relations Commission

Jesse Bethel High School Students from the Vallejo Youth Human Rights Commission presented information regarding the roots of the commission identifying and advocating for human rights in the community through civic engagement. The commission members attend Solano County Board of Supervisors and Vallejo City Hall meetings to raise awareness and propose solutions to local challenges. The commission meetings are on Wednesdays, at Jesse Bethel High School Library from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., in person, or online.

B. Safe Routes to School

Suzanne Antone, Safe Routes to School Program Coordinator, introduced Amy Antunano, who shared presenting information to the committee about their program, resources for students and community events. Safe Routes to School has an Education and Engagement program with the Bike Mobile program that assists and teaches students with minor bike repairs; the helmet fitting program has free helmets for students; A Walk or Wheel (WOW) Day is an ongoing, school-wide event your school can schedule weekly or monthly to encourage students to walk or wheel (by bike, scooter, or skateboard) to school. Schools can market the event as Walk or Wheel (WOW) Day. Ms. Antone said grants were awarded to Dan Mini and Hogan Middle School, and she would like to work with the high schools to support the students needing resources.

VIII. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Nebraska Street Pilot Update

Melissa Tigbao, Director of Public Works for the City of Vallejo, Dan Sakura, Assistant Public Works Director and City Engineer, Mitchell Romao, Assistant Superintendent of Operations for the Vallejo City Unified School District, presented information and updates to the Committee. The committee was given the results of a neighborhood and school survey regarding the street closure and future plans to slow down Nebraska Street traffic.

B. VCUSD Administrative Building Title Transfer

Vice President John Fox introduced the item and asked the City of Vallejo if the process could be expedited and completed, since it's been in place for a while and delayed. Sarah Polito, Attorney for Fagen, Friedman & Fulfroast, representing VCUSD presented information to the committee in regard to the acquisition of the District Office building.
